
The church is God's house. We come together at Mass to worship God.

and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our
God.

Priest: Show us, o Lord, your mercy. **People:** And grant us your salvation



GLORIA

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father.

Lord Jesus Christ,
Only Begotten Son,
Lord God, Lamb of God,
Son of the Father,
you take away the sins
of the world, have mercy on us;
you take away the sins

receive our prayer;

We sit down and listen to the Word of God from the bible.


Lector: The Word of the Lord. **People:** Thanks be to God.


GOSPEL DIALOGUE

Savior of the world,
for by your Cross
and Resurrection,
you have set us free.

Priest: Through him, with him, in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all glory and honor is yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever.

People: Amen.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen
