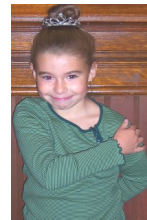
Each time we enter or

THE LORD'S PRAYER

temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen**

SIGN OF PEACE

Priest: The peace of the Lord
be with you always.

People: And with your spirit.

We shake hands, hug, and share Christ's peace with the people
around us. We show that we are one family in Christ.
